

Instructions for Use:

Creating Characters and Printing Stories

Thank you for purchasing StickeyStory. Below you will find the necessary instructions to create and print your personalized stickers that you can use to create your story.

1. Create your Characters

A- Information

Each character will be uploaded one at a time.

- The first character that you enter (Character 1) will be your story's main character, and the rest will go along on the adventure.
- You can enter up to 4 characters for each story.
- You can enter 1, 2, 3, or 4 characters—it is not necessary to enter all 4 characters if you do not wish to.

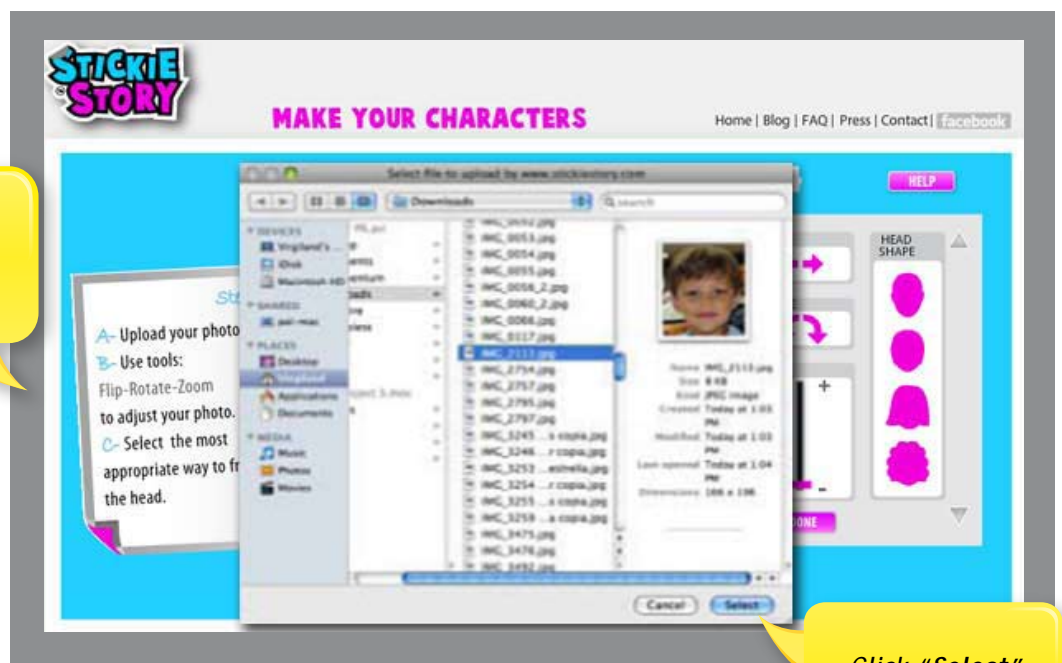

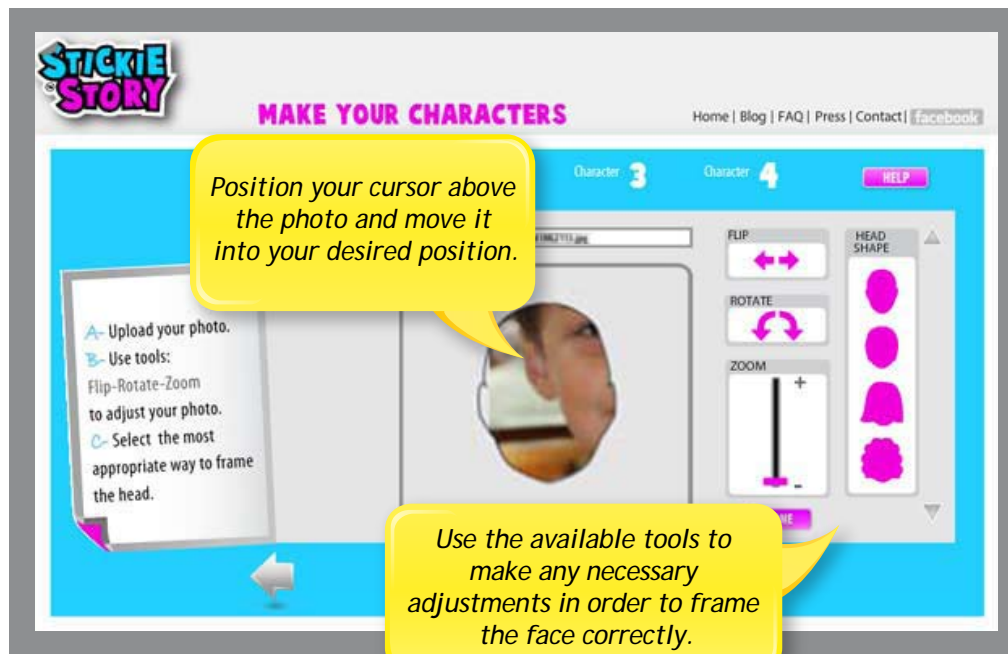
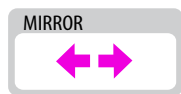
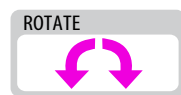


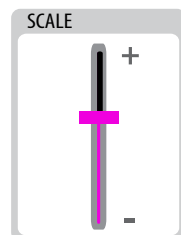
Photo Adjustment Tools:



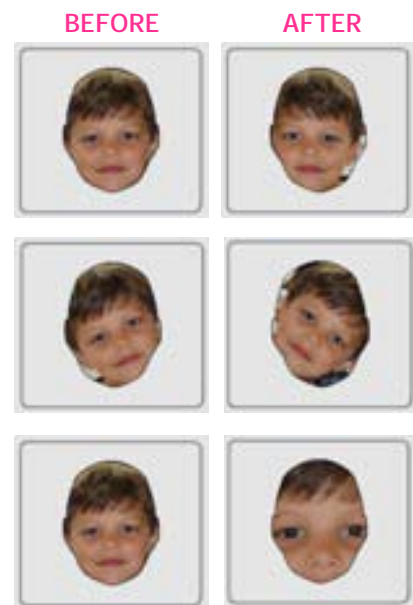
Allows you to mirror flip the photo so that it is exactly the opposite of the original.



Allows you to rotate the photo up to 360°.



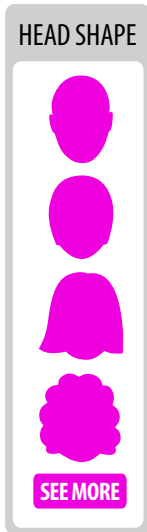
Allows you to make your photo larger or smaller.

Allows you to select the shape that best fits the character. Try to choose the shape that is closest to the shape of the photo you have selected.

2- Printing Stickers

You will be able to save your sheets of personalized stickers and print them as many times as you like.

-Be sure to enter each preview screen to preview each sheet separately.

Print

You will be able to move the heads and bodies of each character to arrange them the way you like.

Position your cursor above each head to arrange it the way you would like, and position it above each body to do the same.

You should use an inkjet printer for this print job. Remember that the shiny side of the printer paper is the side you should print your stickers on. Before printing on the sticker paper, we recommend doing a print test to be sure your printer settings are correct.
